PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

TERM 2

Welcome back to school for Term 2! It was wonderful to see everyone's smiling faces on Monday morning, rested and ready for a very busy and exciting Term 2. As usual, we have a lot of special learning events planned, with opportunities for our students to develop their knowledge and skills across academic, social and sporting areas. Our learning focus this year is Numeracy and our teachers are also refining their skills in the teaching of Mathematics – learning doesn't stop when you are an adult! On **Friday 1**st **May**, we will be having a **Curriculum Day** where teachers will work with Mick Ymer, a Maths specialist, to plan for effective teaching that meets every child's needs. Children will not be at school on this day.

ANZAC DAY CEREMONIES

On Friday 24th April, Miss Hay-Smith and I will be taking the School Captains to the **Anzac ceremonies** at both Johnstone Park and Rice Village. These will be very special ceremonies this year, as we commemorate 100 years since the Anzacs landed at Gallipoli on April 25th, 1915. I am always very proud to take our school captains to these events as they learn more about our history and represent our school very responsibly and respectfully. We will also be discussing the centenary in our classrooms.

INQUIRY UNIT

Our Inquiry this term addresses the big question 'What is the effect of force and energy?' and our students will be investigating the science behind how toys work, how things move and how we source and use energy. Look out for a pompom push-and-pull snake, some rainbow beads, a 'marble run', and a 'solar pizza oven' among other exciting adventures!

SPORT ACTIVITIES

Term 2 is also a very busy time for **sporting activities** and we have many students participating in the District Cross Country coming up at Barwon Valley Park on April 24th. This term we will be offering Gymnastics for the Prep-2 students, Hockey for the Grade 1-4 students, footy clinics for all students and preparing for the Grade 3-6 Athletics Sports with Belmont PS on Thursday, 28th May. Mr. Gardiner will keep you informed with more details as the term progresses.

PARENT HELPERS PROGRAM

We are also offering our **Parent Helpers program** again for those parents who would like to come into the classroom as a helper, or would like to help their children at home. The first session will be held on Tuesday 28th April at 9am in the Meeting Room (near the Office) with the lovely Mrs. Brough who will be explaining how to best assist your child with developing their reading skills.
